In-Training Exam

A computerized multiple-choice 100 question exam will be administered to all residents 9 months into the residency and prior to graduation. PA residents will be given the time away from their services for this purpose. If PA Resident is on vacation exam must be taken before or week after vacation. Vacation time is allowed during this testing, but the resident must sit for the exam.

PA residents are encouraged to use the results of the exam to recognize areas needing further study. The In-Training exam is excellent preparation for the Certification Added Qualification Exam.

Final Exam

PA residents are required to take a final exam consisting of 50 multiple choice questions in the final months of their residency with a required passing score of 70%. PA residents will be given time away from their services for this purpose.

Rosh Tests

Residents must take the online Rosh tests as set in the curriculum and residency graduation requirements.

PANCE Exam

Physician Assistant residents-1st year must take and pass the PANCE exam prior to licensing by state of MN and hospital credentialing
